



The Nepean Sailing Club invites you to attend The Nepean One Design Regatta 2010 to be held June 26-27, 2010 at the Nepean Sailing Club in Ottawa, Canada

## NOTICE OF RACE

Amended March 23, 2010

- 1 RULES**
  - 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
  - 1.2 Class rules of each competing class will apply.
- 2 ADVERTISING**
  - 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**
  - 3.1 The regatta is open to keelboat classes Laser 28, C&C 27 (Mk 1-4), Kirby 25, J/24, Shark, Tanzer 22 and Ultimate 20 subject to 3.5.
  - 3.2 The regatta is open to dinghy classes 505, Fireball, Albacore, 420 and Laser subject to 3.6.  
The regatta will be the Ontario Championship for the Albacore class.
  - 3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the On-line [Registration Form](#). On-line registration will be available until 17:00 June 23<sup>rd</sup>. If payment is made by mailed cheque, the cheque **must arrive no later than June 18, 2010** (see registration form for a list of payment methods.)
  - 3.4 Late entries (June 25, 2010 after 21:00) may be accepted only under **exceptional circumstances for out of town sailors at the discretion of the regatta chair.**
  - 3.5 Should a keelboat class have fewer than six fully registered boats by 17:00, June 1, 2010; that class will be cancelled and all fees returned.

- 3.6 Should a dinghy class have fewer than six fully registered boats by 21:00, June 25, 2010; that class will be cancelled and all fees returned.

#### **4 FEES**

- 4.1 Required Fees are as follows:

##### **Before 17:00, June 1, 2010**

Keelboat classes -\$120.00

Dinghy classes, double handed - \$85.00

Dinghy classes, single handed - \$65.00

##### **After 17:00, June 1, 2010**

Keelboat classes - \$145.00 \* Only available if minimum fleet size met by June 1<sup>st</sup>.

Dinghy classes, double handed - \$110.00

Dinghy classes, single handed - \$90.00

Required fees include three dinner tickets for each boat in keelboat classes, two dinner tickets for each boat in double handed dinghy classes and one dinner ticket for each boat in single handed dinghy classes.

- 4.2 Additional dinner tickets for the Saturday evening meal may be purchased during registration at a cost of \$20 each.

#### **5 SCHEDULE**

- 5.1 Registration:

**On-line:** Eligible boats may register on-line until 17:00 June 23, 2010.

Early registration using the on-line form is strongly encouraged.

**In person:** Eligible boats may register in person according to the following schedule:

Wednesday, June 23 from 19:30-21:00.

Thursday, June 24 from 19:30-21:00.

Friday, June 25 from 1800-21:00.

Pre-registered boats must check in during the in person registration period or on Saturday morning before 9:00.

- 5.2 Dates of racing:  
Saturday, June 26  
Sunday, June 27

The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 10:00.

- 5.3 Skippers Meeting:

The skippers meeting will be held on Saturday, June 26 at 8:30.

5.4 Launch and Haulout:  
Keelboats will be launched and hauled free of charge at NSC.  
Keelboats may be launched on June 25 from 9:00-23:00.  
Haulout will commence after racing on Sunday with priority given to out of town boats.

5.5 Prize Giving:  
Prizes will be awarded as soon as possible following racing on Sunday.

## 6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on the NOD website approximately one week prior to the regatta. Hard copies will be available during the in person registration and on Saturday morning before 9:00.

## 7 VENUE

### Racing

Races will be held on Lac Deschenes north of the NSC harbour.

### Accommodations

Camping will be available on NSC grounds. Washroom and shower facilities are open 24 hours. Several hotels/motels are within 10 minutes driving.

### Food

Light breakfast will be provided to competitors as part of the regatta fee starting at 8:00 on Saturday and Sunday.

Lunch boxes may purchased for Saturday and/or Sunday. Tickets must be purchased by Friday, June 25 at 21:00.

Saturday dinner will be served at 18:30. Some Saturday dinner tickets are provided as part of the regatta entry fee. Additional tickets must be purchased by Friday, June 25 at 21:00.

After the completion of racing, you may purchase food from the bar menu.

## 8 THE COURSES

The courses will be sailed as follows:

Keelboats: Windward / Leeward

Dinghies: Windward / Leeward Triangle

as defined in the Sailing Instructions.

## 9 SCORING

9.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply. RRS A4.1 table is modified to read 0.75 points for first place in Low Point System.

- 9.2 (a) When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.  
(b) When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.  
(c) The Ultimate 20 fleet will not have any drop races.

**10 BERTHING**

Keelboats from out of town will be berthed at one of the Service Docks on the east side of the NSC harbour or along the harbour wall in front of the clubhouse. Out of town dinghies will be accommodated in the dry sail area established for NSC dinghies.

**11 HAULOUT RESTRICTIONS**

Keelboats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

**12 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

**13 PRIZES**

Prizes will be awarded to the top three boats in each fleet.  
Prizes will be awarded to the top five boats at the Albacore Ontario Championships.

**14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**15 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party general liability insurance, in an amount not less than \$1,000,000.
